ROTARY is a service organization of business and professional persons united worldwide who have accepted the ideal of service as the real basis for attaining success and happiness in personal, business and community life. The first ROTARY CLUB was formed on 23rd February, 1905 in Chicago by a lawyer, Paul P. Harris.

ROTARY has over 1.2 million service-minded members belonging to 33,790 Rotary clubs in 207 countries. Rotary International is the association of all Rotary Clubs worldwide. The Rotary International Headquarters is in Evanston, Illinois, U.S.A. The name Rotary was derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among members' offices.

Rotary International District 3150 (comprising 85 clubs in 38 cities/towns of 11 revenue districts in Andhra Pradesh) is one among the 534 Rotary Districts in the world.
